Unplanned Pregnancy Services

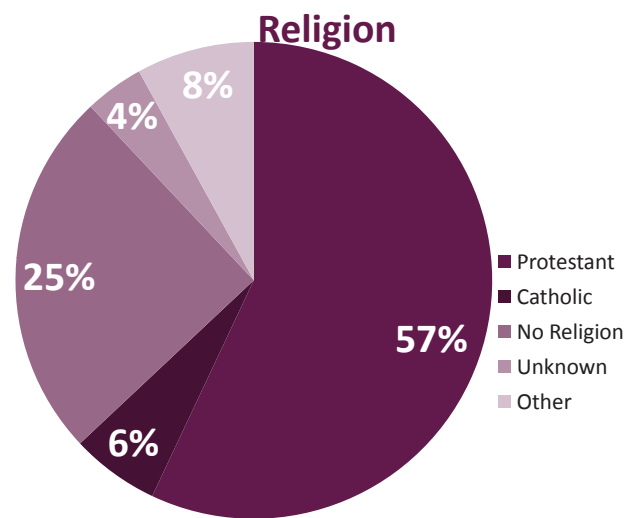
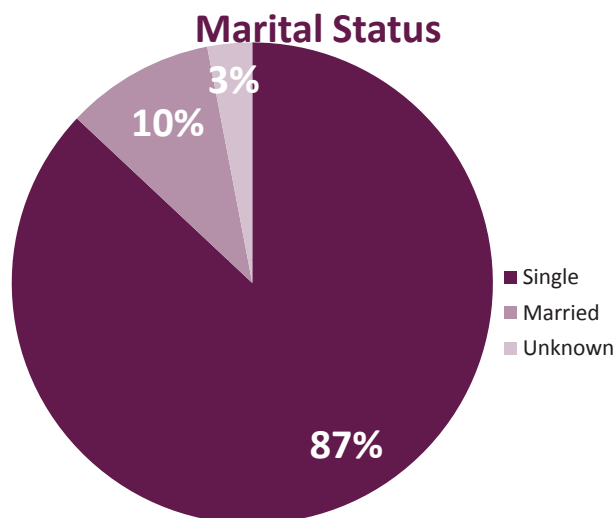
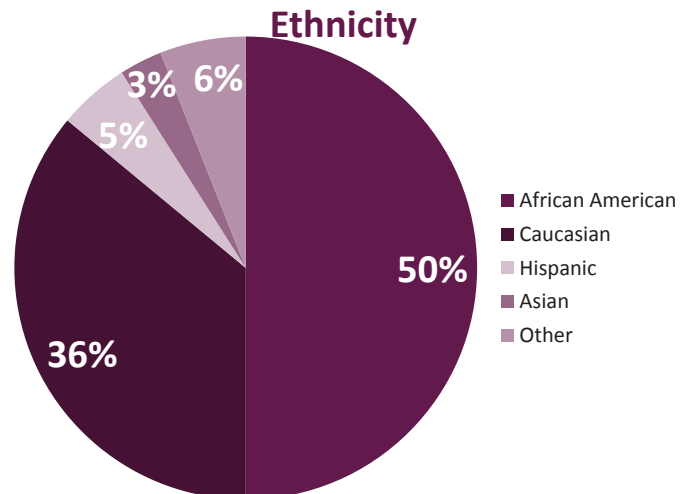
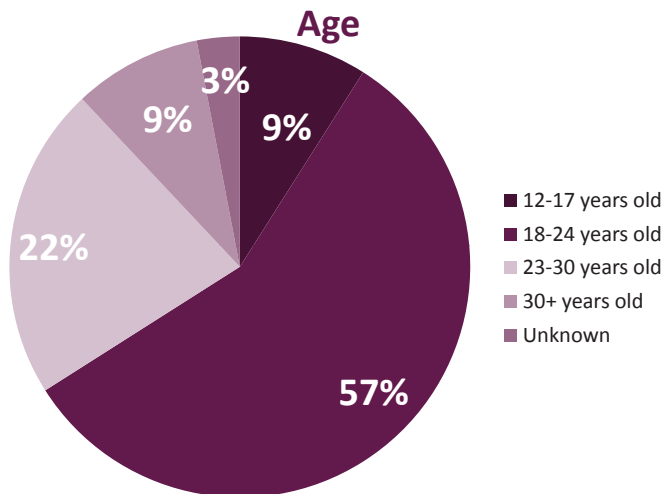
Phone consultation

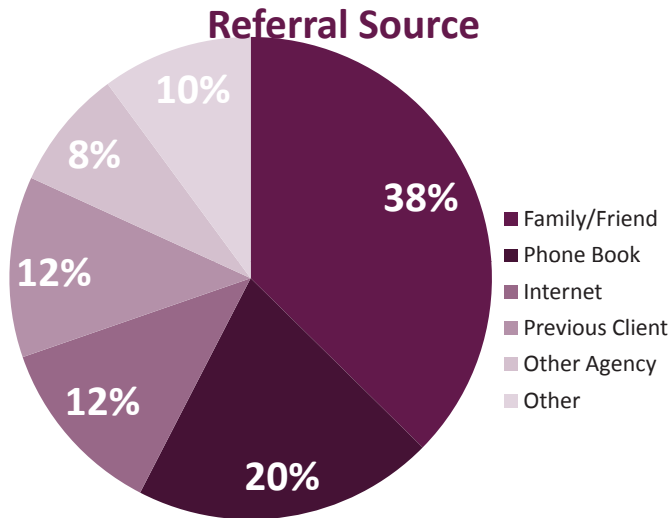
- 826 new unplanned pregnancy clients
- 244 returning unplanned pregnancy clients
- 476 women were assisted with practical support and referrals

- 450 new unplanned pregnancy clients
- 38 New BRIDGE had 232 education and material assistance sessions

Client Post Service Survey Results (Pregnancy Services)

100% were treated with respect and honesty.
 100% would refer their friends to Hope Clinic for Women
 100% would consider returning to Hope Clinic for future services.
 For Negative pregnancy test clients: 88% are definitely considering a healthier life choices
 For Positive pregnancy test clients: 97% feel more informed of their options.

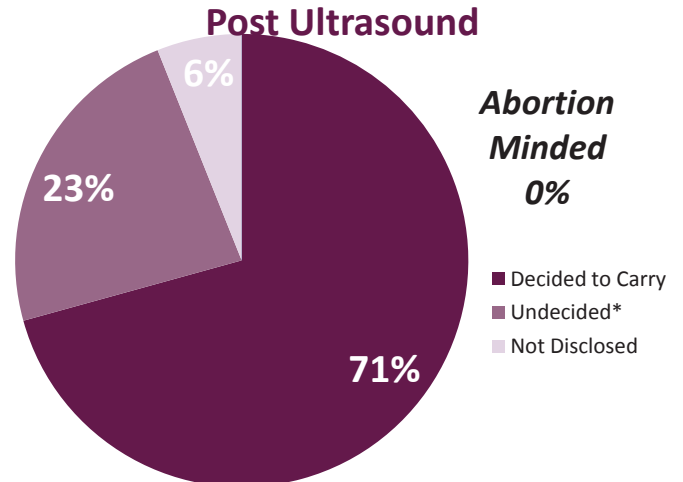
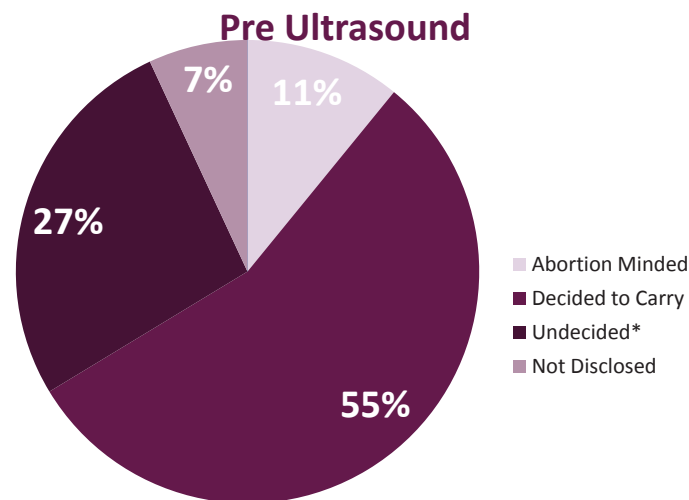
Counseling Services

78 male partners of our female clients received 89 hours of counseling
 26 Couples received 80 hours of couples's therapy
 12 Parents of our female clients received 22 hours of counseling
 18 of our pregnancy service clients receive 97 hours of professional counseling
 15 new Post Abortion clients received 60 hours of professional counseling

Medical Services

1,150 phone consultation clients
 Nearly 900 onsite medical clients, 22% increase from 2007
 16% Ultrasounds, pre-natal education for pregnant clients
 73% Sexually transmitted Infection (STI) testing/treating and Paps
 12% Medical consult only

Post Service Client Survey Results (Medical Services)

- 100% said they were treated with respect and honesty
- 64.4% said they were likely to consider abstinence as a result of their visit
- 100% said they were more informed about STIs and health
- 68% said they would plan to make lifestyle changes
- 100% said they would refer Hope Clinic to a friend

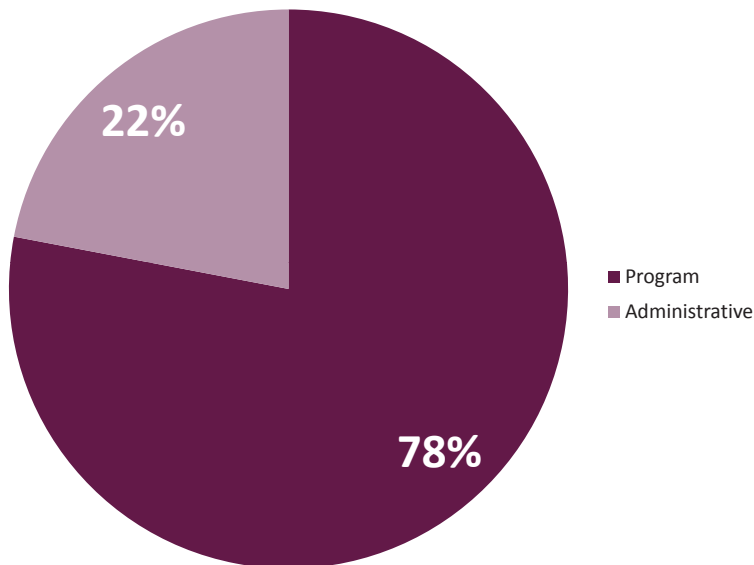
Prevention Services

Reached thousand of student and young adults in Davidson & Williamson county training young women and men to choose abstinence and giving them the tools to achieve it.

A total of nearly 4,400 unique participants; over 6,000 encounters (over multiple visits)

- 1,900 unique students reached at 19 middle and high schools (public and private)
- 900 unique students reached at community based organizations including YMCA programs with repeat sessions for a total of 2000 encounters
- 450 College students at Belmont University and MTSU
- 1100 student, young adults and parents reached at 13 different churches
- 46 attended wHoly Sex Bible Study
 - 2 Women' Group at Hope Clinic (19 women)
 - 2 Men's Group at Hope Clinic (12 men)
 - 1 Women's Group in Antioch (6 women)

-Wendy's Place: Hope Clinic's Home for Moms and Babies is now open and remains at full capacity as we continue to meet the needs of our clients. The first baby has already been born and we hope that she is the first of many lives saved through this new endeavor.

-In partnership with St. Thomas Health Services, Hope Clinic for Women is now the **only** organization in Middle Tennessee offering specialized assessment and treatment of postpartum depression.

-Nearly 600 volunteers gave 4,000 hours serving clients, assisting in the office, working in the clothes closet and at Wendy's Place, and helping with events.
