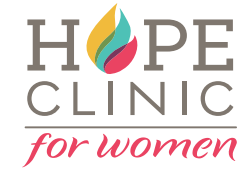

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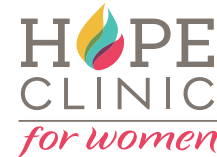

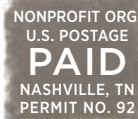

A Letter From Our CEO

Dear friends,

Welcome 2018!! Did you know this March Hope Clinic for Women celebrates 35 years? 35!!!! And I just celebrated my 14th year with Hope Clinic. I cannot begin to express my gratitude to those of you who have supported us this entire time and those of you just beginning your partnership with us. I am humbled with every check I see, every online donation, every volunteer that comes in to help and the staff who serve so faithfully. I know there are easy jobs and jobs that may pay a lot more; but I am grateful I serve a team that is called to this great work. Everyone connected to Hope Clinic puts their heart and soul into everything they do. And my amazing board and advisory board. How they have guided me, corrected me, loved me and supported me all of these years. Leadership; especially in this arena is not for the faint of heart and frankly if not for God's prompting, I myself would have taken an easier road. But God. BUT GOD!! He is guiding this ministry and HE will complete the work He began.

IN 2017 WE DECIDED TO REACH BEYOND THESE FOUR WALLS. In the summer we added texting options for our clients and now are available nights and weekends through texting and social media inquiries. We always want to be available to our clients. We taped many of our Pregnancy Bridge education classes for clients to watch at their convenience. This option was so well received we are working with a church to professionally tape 10 of our key classes so clients can stream them online. We never want childcare or transportation to be a reason our clients can't get our care. Once that rolls out we will be offering 'subscriptions' to more rural area pregnancy centers who want to offer these types of classes at their center but do not have the staff/volunteers/funds to do so.

IN 2018 WE ARE FOCUSED ON OUTCOMES. While we are grateful for the incredible growth from last year we know that simply growing numbers is not enough. What matters most is ensuring those who come here, access all of our services and leave healthier, more equipped and able to live more comfortably. So we are looking at everything we offer a client; how our services cross over each other, how we capture data and analyze it and how we are meeting clients' needs and where are the gaps. We simply want to be the best there is to offer in Middle Tennessee regardless of where the client is on the political or socioeconomic scale.

CLIENT PROGRAM OUTCOMES*:

PREGNANCY:

808 Total pregnant families helped

- This includes the 621 clients who started with a pregnancy test, those remaining in the program from the previous year and those referred by other agencies who are in their 2nd/3rd trimester.
- Nearly 50% of women contacting us are abortion minded.
- 79% came in for follow up ultrasound visits/care.
- For those coming back for follow up care, over 80% choose life.
- 838 Bridge sessions completed (counseling and mentoring).
- 600 Bridge classes offered.

PREVENTION & OUTREACH:

535 Women received Pap testing and STD testing/treatment

- Each visit included an education portion to improve healthy choices and offered counseling

GRIEF CARE/ COUNSELING:

155 People came in for counseling completing 1,250 counseling sessions

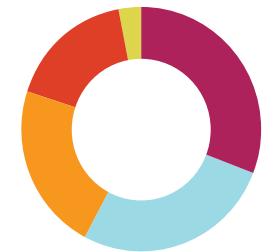
