A Letter From Our CEO

DO YOU KNOW WHAT MANY OF US WORKING AT PREGNANCY CENTERS WORRY ABOUT? With all the talk of conservative people in office, we worry people think the work is done and the fight is over. But those of us working with hundreds of pregnant women every year know that if anything our work will only grow. Where will these women go? They go to places like Hope Clinic. So dear friends, pray with me that people do not grow complacent or weary of supporting our work. We continue to need your time, talents and financial resources. Whether I meet the most conservative or liberal person, once they hear what we do they say: "Wow! You need to exist in our community." Yes. Yes, we do! And we do not have government funding keeping our doors open. YOU do that! So, thank you!!

WE WILL BE CLOSING OUR FISCAL YEAR SEPTEMBER 30TH and need financial gifts of all sizes to ensure we finish strong. We also need you to continue raising awareness of our services, not only in your community, but in the most underserved populations. We don't have the advertising dollars the big national agencies do and nearly 50% of our clients come in to us through word-of-mouth referrals from friends or family members.

THIS YEAR WE CONTINUED TO GROW OUR REACH INTO THE COMMUNITY as traffic and travel became more difficult for clients. What seems to work best is being available to clients online, with classes, counseling and mentor sessions. We seek to continually improve this process and hope to someday offer our services to pregnancy centers across the state who do not have the resources we do. In fact, this year, I will be taking our prevention 'sexual risk avoidance' material to the women of Haiti and India. Through our partnership with Grace Chapel, Hope Clinic is sharing valuable tools with women everywhere. This isn't just a US problem but a global issue. We all need to heal and equip from the inside out.

PREGNANCY LOSS AWARENESS MONTH: October



Hope Clinic provides individual and group counseling for all forms of pregnancy loss (miscarriage, stillbirth, infant death, failed IVF/Adoption and past abortions). All are unique and come with a full range of emotions that can last for many years while women and men suffer in silence. At Hope Clinic, we seek to heal the pain and lift the feeling of isolation that may come after experiencing a pregnancy loss. Both male and female counselors are available to walk with you towards hope and healing.

We are aware that the loss from an abortion is even more complex, especially when it is compounded by comments on social media. We specifically offer post-abortion counseling and support for women and men in three ways. The Uncovering Hope gift offers a token of our support in this charged and sensitive topic. Our female and male counselors are available to provide weekly support through individual, couple, and group counseling. We also offer weekend intensives to pull back from everyday life and focus on healing. If you are recovering from any form of pregnancy loss and would like to speak to someone about our services, please contact us at 615-321-0005. An option for a private line to the Counseling Department will be provided.

WOMEN'S COMPREHENSIVE CARE

"As we finish up our 35th year, our CEO Renée has reminded us of just how far we have come. I am delighted to say that our medical staff has expanded to three part-time Women's Health nurse practitioners to provide STD testing and full well women exams (\$25-75), three RN's certified for 1st trimester ultrasounds, and three RN's for our pregnancy tests and STD follow up care. As I go into the community, I share about our services to agencies, doctors' offices and most importantly the communities in the most underserved populations. Through a grant with the March of Dimes, I have been able to begin monthly meetings in the community on smoking cessation during pregnancy at the J.C. Napier complex. We are able to supply these families with gift cards and diapers while educating them on all of our services. I cannot begin to thank each and every one of you for your support, allowing us to empower these women."
