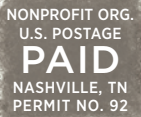

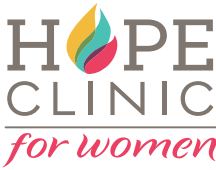

A Letter From Our CEO

Dear Friends,

Happy 2020! I know everyone is playing off 2020 relating it to vision and we joined that bandwagon last year when we started praying about our Gala theme. But for us, 2020 isn't about perfect vision. Our aim in 2020 is more about seeing people with our hearts and with the mind of Christ. We want to know our clients. They want to feel seen and be heard. They want to be understood. Don't we all want that? I will be sharing more about this at the Gala on February 27th (if you haven't bought your tickets I would love to see you this year) and throughout the year but it is a paramount viewpoint if we want to truly impact the women we serve and help empower and equip them for a bright future.

We exploded with clients this past fiscal year (fiscal close was September 30th) and the new year is already off to a strong start. Women come to us because of the mind, body, spirit approach we take regardless of what services they need. And they come back or recommend us because we treat them with respect and unconditional love, no matter her story or her choices. This fiscal year we launched our year-long partnership with People Loving Nashville (after a test period last year) and Operation Saving Life as we work together to bring our services mobile to the most vulnerable women who cannot get into our clinic. Three days a week we are on a mobile unit in the community.

We successfully launched an online education program using BrightCourse material (an organization servicing pregnancy centers across the country) and a deeper ability to provide case management to clients who are in desperate need of things from the community (housing, daycare, jobs, etc.). And finally, the 30 pregnancy centers that exist in Tennessee are in constant contact ensuring we are partnering together, referring clients back and forth based on location and need, and becoming a united voice for young women.

CLIENT PROGRAM OUTCOMES\*:

PREGNANCY:

≈1,000 | Total pregnancy families helped

- Over 65% of women contacting us are still considering an abortion
- Over 80% came in for follow up ultrasound visits/care.
- For those coming back for follow up care, over 83% choose life.
- One third of clients utilized the Pregnancy Bridge Program allowing them access to free counseling, case management, education classes, and spiritual mentorship in exchange for material assistance.

≈700 | women received pap testing and STD testing/treatment

- Each visit included an education portion to improve healthy choices and offered counseling

- Of those students, 83% said they would commit to making healthier sexual choices.

COUNSELING:
