### SAFE VOLUNTEERING AT HOPE CLINIC

Volunteering at Hope Clinic for Women is exciting and life-affirming. We are always open and ready to receive new people to join our team of amazing volunteers. We have both "behind the scenes" options and opportunities to work directly with our clients. Some volunteer positions can be done virtually or remotely, while some options require coming to our clinic. If you have questions about what volunteering at Hope Clinic looks like, contact Shanera Williamson at swilliamson@hopeclinicforwomen.org. Here are some of our biggest needs for volunteers:

**PREGNANCY BRIDGE MENTORS** Provide one-on-one mentoring to our bridge clients. Mentors serve as a cheerleader and coach for our pregnant clients offering support and steadiness during a time filled with change and challenges. We need at least 60 more mentors. The commitment is 2 mentor sessions – typically an hour – twice a month. We also specifically need 10 male mentors to connect with the partners of our pregnant clients.

**CLOTHING ROOM ASSISTANCE** We need about 5 people to give us 1 to 2 hours every other week to help process the donations that come in for our clothing room. This is perfect for the person who gets joy out of organizing with a knack for always putting things in their proper place.

### **CELEBRATING RENÉE RIZZO**

### 18 Years Of Bold Leadership



ur founders from 1983 are described as physicians, pastors, counselors, and community leaders, but beyond all of those titles our founders were trailblazers. One of the indelible qualities that Renee has honored during her time as the third leader of this ministry is to continue to be a maverick for the women that we serve. She chose to push the limits of what pregnancy centers could provide, the level of excellence that could be expected, and the depth of love that could be expressed. In honor of Renée's departure from Hope Clinic at the end of this fiscal year, we would like to outline some of the accomplishments that occurred during her tenure:

### **PREGNANCY SERVICES:**

- Implementation of the Bridge
  Parenting Program in 2008 created
  a pathway to "abundant life" for
  moms and dads choosing life for
  their child. This program today
  equips participants with mentoring,
  education classes, case management,
  counseling, and all the material goods
  they need for a successful pregnancy
  and first year of the child's life.
  - This program moved to a hybrid model even before COVID and virtual classes and mentoring is even more engaging now!

#### **MEDICAL SERVICES:**

 We took a bold leap forward with the hiring a full-time Nurse Practitioner in 2005 and added Well-woman exams in 2016.

### **RELATIONSHIP EDUCATION:**

• While founded in 1998, this program was reintroduced after losing federal funding with a full suite of offerings for public, private, and charter schools, teachers, parents, youth leaders, and churches – and we continue to serve over 1,000/year through this preventative education.

### **COUNSELING:**

- Graduate Practicum students from universities all over Middle Tennessee began providing medical and clinical care in 2007 and continue to serve 120+ clients/year, especially to receive professional counseling during their pregnancy for free.
- Post-abortion counseling expanded to include all forms of pregnancy loss in 2008 through our partnership St. Thomas Health Services.
   Postpartum Depression counseling was added a couple years later also because of expressed need from area healthcare centers.

#### **BUSINESS**

- Bringing her finance background and business acumen Renée consistently ensured healthy fiscal budgeting year after year, cutting expenses by 25% and increasing client capacity by nearly 400%
  - As of January 2021 Hope Clinic is officially debt free due to generous supporters and faithful debt payments made throughout the last decade.
- Hope Clinic has been set up for success with 90 day cash reserves, Standard Operating Procedures for all organizational areas, and nearly \$200,000 in our endowment fund.

We are so grateful for the service, the expertise, and the passion that Renée has brought to this ministry through the years. She has spent as much time balancing the budget and leading strategically as she has spent teaching high school students to make healthy choices, mentoring clients, teaching exercise classes, and baking cookies for donors. Her service and sacrifice has made Hope Clinic the staple that it is today and we are so excited to see what this next season will bring for us trusting that God will continue to provide abundantly as he has the last 38 years!






